Chablis Gallery is located in the historic gold rush town of Placerville, on Main Street at the corner of Center and Main. It is housed in a beautifully renovated old building formerly known as the Professional Building. The present building has been extensively remodeled with light walls and textured surfaces, the transformation has been amazing. Gallery visitors are greeted by the phenomenal "Sunday Drive" bronze sculpture depicting a 1906 Pope Toledo auto being hauled by a farmer and his draft horse team after the family becomes hopelessly stuck! The creator, Montillier, has recreated real life scenes in many wonderful and bizarre bronzes including airplanes, Bugatti's and Maserati's replicas, free standing as well as revolving art pieces.

Hosting many original paintings of several well-established artists, Urania Christy Tarbet stands out with her brilliance, using pastel and oils while specializing in brilliant floral still lifes and gardenscapes. Her work is exhibited

around the world and her credentials are numerous. Plein aire painter, Robert Moore creates magnificent works of aspens and western vistas. Award winning artist, Robert Gardner has equine and western scenes appearing in realistic and romanticized scenes.

Hillside and farmland landscapes are compositions presented by Dolores Justus, available as unframed, gallery wrapped canvases. Lisa Homan-Conger paintings step right into a live experience of vivid bistro and cafés with dazzling nightlife.

Of great landscape oil painters featured at the gallery include the acclaimed works of Robert Wee, who offers powerful seascapes. The grand splendor of Yosemite in pastels can be viewed by Teresa Webber. California impressionist, Leandro, is best known for sensuous still lifes. Rounding out the gallery are stone and bronze sculptures from Tom Munson, Richard Ratcliff, Gloria Bradley and Julie Larusson. Pottery and porcelain is carried by Bruce Fairman. A viewing room is provided with comfortable chairs and adjustable lighting. Special reception and show is scheduled for March 16, 6-9pm at the gallery, featuring "Sierra Landscapes" by Robert Wee.
